

WEST VIRGINIA HOW THIS INSURANCE APPLIES ENDORSEMENT

This endorsement applies only to the insurance provided by the policy because West Virginia is shown in Item 3.A. of the Information Page.

As provided by various sections of the West Virginia Workers Compensation Code and related rules, benefits awarded for bodily injury arising out of occupational disease, including hearing loss and occupational pneumoconiosis, may be allocated among policies covering specific dates of last exposure for employers identified by the Insurance Commissioner as chargeable in such awards.

Section A. How This Insurance Applies of Part One (Workers Compensation Insurance) of the policy is replaced by:

A. How This Insurance Applies

This workers compensation insurance applies to bodily injury by accident or bodily injury by disease including occupational pneumoconiosis and hearing loss. Bodily injury includes resulting death.

1. Bodily injury by accident must occur in the course of and resulting from your employment during the policy period.
2. Bodily injury by disease must be caused or aggravated by the conditions of your employment. The employee's last day of last exposure to the conditions causing or aggravating such bodily injury by disease, or the last day of exposure identified by the Insurance Commissioner as the basis for charging you in an allocated benefit award, must occur during the policy period.

This endorsement changes the policy to which it is attached and is effective on the date issued unless otherwise stated.
